Dr. Susana Garrido is a Senior Researcher at the Portuguese Institute for Sea and Atmosphere (IPMA). Her research mainly focuses on the trophic dynamics of pelagic fish, stock structure and understanding the impact of environmental variability on population dynamics. In her work, Susana uses complementary techniques, from laboratory experimentation to gut content analysis, fatty acid biomarkers stable isotopes. Her additional research interests include zooplankton ecology and maternal effects. Susana currently leads the Research Group on Coastal Pelagic Fish and the Trophic Ecology Laboratory at IPMA and has been trying to provide managers with environmental indicators of population dynamics for pelagic species.
